- Point 4: Hill 102; the advance of the 3rd Division continues, August 8th, 1918*
- Point 5: Le Quesnel Canadian Battlefield Memorial; the attack of the 4th Division, August 8th, 1918*
- Point 6: Manitoba Cemetery; the attack of the 1st Division, August 9th, 1918*
- Point 7: Fouquescourt British Cemetery; the attack of the 4th Division, August 10th, 1918*
- Point 8: Parvillers; the assault of the 3rd Division, August 12th-15th, 1918*
- Point 9: Toronto Cemetery; the advance of the 1st Division continues, August 8th, 1918*



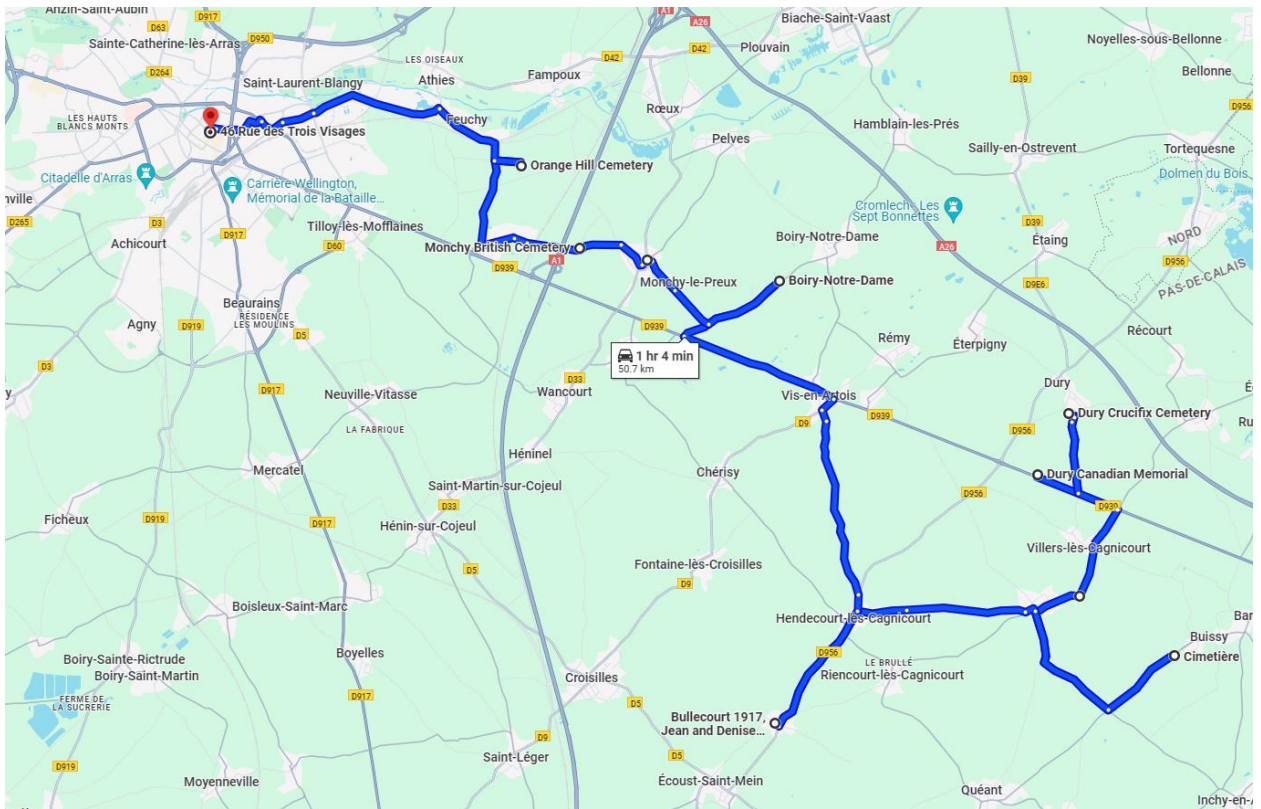
